

## Circular No. 40/2023

Sub: Guideline for Admission Cancellation and Refund of Fee for the students admitted in Academic Year 2023-24.

It is hereby informed to all Principals/Heads that the guideline for Admission Cancellation and Refund of fees for the Students admitted in Academic Year **2023-24** is as under:

## A. Cancellation of Admission:

For the cancellation of admission for Academic Year 2023-24 students shall apply through ERP only. Such students can visit <a href="https://erp.ganpatuniversity.ac.in">https://erp.ganpatuniversity.ac.in</a> and login using their ERP User ID and Password. For detailed information for cancellation of admission please refer to the Annexure-A.

The candidate has to submit the original fee receipt, No-Due Certificate & College ID-Card in Original at respective Institute, if applicable.

## B. Refund of Fees for the students admitted in A. Y. 2023-24 only

- 1. In case of cancellation of admission for whatsoever reason, the college or institution in which the candidate has taken admission shall process the Admission Cancellation formalities through Online Portal and University will refund the fee as per the guideline mentioned in table below;
- 2. The refund of fees will be deposited online to the A/C (as per information provided by the student) after completion of Admission Cancellation Process.

Sr. No.	Particular	Refund Amount
1	Up to 30 <sup>th</sup> September 2023	Entire fee paid by the candidate will be refunded
2	If the date of Submission of Online Application for Admission Cancellation is during <b>1</b> <sup>st</sup> <b>Oct 31</b> <sup>st</sup> <b>Oct. 2023.</b>	Fee paid refund after deduction of Rs.1000/- as administrative charges
3	If the date of Submission of Online Application for Admission Cancellation is after <b>October 31</b> , <b>2023</b> .	As per UGC Notification

#### Note:

- 1) In case of students admitted through ACPC/ACPDC/Medical, the guideline of respective bodies shall be followed.
- 2) In case of cancellation of admission at college or institute level on the request of the student after the deadline mentioned in table, s/he shall be liable to pay the fees for the current semester.



All Principals and Heads of the Constituent Institutions /Colleges /Departments/Centers are informed to communicate the date of closure of admission of respective programmes to the university office and also bring to the notice of all students and concerned staff members.



## **Process Flow of Admission Cancellation through ERP:**

- 1. <a href="https://erp.ganpatuniversity.ac.in">https://erp.ganpatuniversity.ac.in</a> and login using their ERP **User ID** and **Password.** 
  - Note: For the query related to **User ID** and **Password** for Login GUNI ERP the candidate may contact the Student Section of respective Institute.
- 2. Click on the "Student Admission Cancellation Request" option. Verify/Fill the required Information correctly and Candidate submit request on ERP portal



- 3. Principal/Head of the respective Institute will put remarks in the admission cancellation application from his/her ERP account after counselling the candidate.
- 4. Admin section will check details and put remarks and forward to the University Office.
- 5. The University Office will check details and approve the cancellation of admission and forward the application in the account section if refund of fees required in the a/c as per details provided by the student (if any).

Subject: Fee Refund Policy 2023-24

Respected Madam/Sir,

The University Grants Commission receives many representations/complaints from the students/parents on the non-refund of fees by the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) on cancellation/withdrawal of admissions.

Students should be allowed a full refund of fees within a specified period to opt for a course they choose.

The Commission has considered the matter in its 570th meeting held on 27 June 2023, and after considering the relevant factors decided, the following fee refund policy for the academic session 2023-24:

- Notwithstanding anything contained in any guidelines/ prospectus/ notification/ schedule, a full refund of fees shall be made by the HEIs on account of all cancellations of admission/migrations of students up to 30 September 2023 and with a deduction of not more than Rs. 1,000, as a processing fee, up to 31 October 2023.
- For any admission schedule extending/commencing beyond/after 31 October 2023, the provisions contained in the UGC Notification issued in October 2018 on Refund of Fees and Non-Retention of Original Certificates shall apply (reproduced below for ready reference):

	Percentage of Refund of fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the HEI
(1)	100%	15 days or more <b>before</b> the formally notified last date of admission
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days <b>before</b> the formally notified last date of admission
(3)	80%	15 days or less <b>after</b> the formally notified last date of admission
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days <b>after formally</b> notified last date of admission
(5)	00%	More than 30 days <b>after</b> formally notified last date of admission

It may also be noted that the UGC has notified the Redressal of Grievances of Students Regulations, 2023 wherein "delay in, or denial of, the refund of fees due to a student who withdraws admission within the time mentioned in the prospectus, subject to guidelines, if any, issued by the Commission, from time to time" has been defined as one of the grievances.

The Higher Education Institutions are requested to ensure compliance with the fee refund policy for the academic session 2023-24 and redress any grievance by the provisions of the University Grants Commission (Redressal of Grievances of Students) Regulations, 2023.

Any HEI violating the provisions of UGC Fee Refund Policy 2023-24 shall be liable for punitive action as notified in Clause 5 of the UGC Notification on Refund of Fees and Non-Retention of Original Certificates issued in October 2018.
